August 6, 2026, Crossfield, Alta. – **Town of Crossfield Receives More Than \$3.7 Million in Provincial Infrastructure Funding**

The Town of Crossfield is pleased to announce that the Government of Alberta is providing more than \$3.7 million in grant funding to support two significant infrastructure projects in the community.

The Town will receive:

- **\$3,393,487.50** through the Alberta Municipal Water/Wastewater Partnership for the **Wastewater Lagoon Treatment Expansion**; and
- **\$328,725** through the Strategic Transportation Infrastructure Program's Local Road Bridge funding stream for a **Culvert Replacement on Western Drive**.

Together, the grants represent a provincial investment of **\$3,722,212.50** in Crossfield's critical municipal infrastructure.

The Wastewater Lagoon Treatment Expansion is an important component of the Town's work to address wastewater capacity, improve the performance and reliability of the existing system and support the community's continued growth.

The Culvert Replacement will address an important transportation infrastructure need on Western Drive and help maintain a safe and reliable connection for residents, businesses and emergency services.

"This provincial investment is tremendous news for Crossfield and will help us move forward with two essential infrastructure projects," said Mayor Kim Harris. "The wastewater lagoon expansion is critical to supporting our community's long-term sustainability and responsible growth, while the Western Drive culvert replacement will improve the safety and reliability of an important transportation connection. On behalf of Council and the community, I would like to thank the Government of Alberta for recognizing these needs and investing in Crossfield's future."

The Town has identified reliable infrastructure readiness as a key strategic priority. Provincial funding partnerships help municipalities advance major projects while reducing the financial burden placed directly on local taxpayers and utility customers.

The Town will continue to provide updates as the projects move through design, procurement and construction.
