FIREFIGHTER - POSITIONAL ANALYSIS

Fire-fighting is a very high risk occupation. The working environment during emergencies can be hostile and unpredictable at times. The workplace for emergency operations is totally variable, depending upon the nature of the emergency. The work is often strenuous and stressful. It is also very rewarding!

Duties include, but are not limited to:

- ✓ Protecting life, environment and property,
- ✓ Controlling and extinguishing different types of fires;
- ✓ Positioning and climbing ladders;
- ✓ Assisting EMS with patient care;
- ✓ Operating and maintaining specialized fire apparatus;
- ✓ Operating and maintaining a variety of hydraulic, pneumatic and power tools;
- ✓ Participating in weekly training sessions, maintaining at least 75% attendance
- ✓ Participating in courses deemed necessary by the fire department as required;
- ✓ Other duties as required by the Fire Chief or their designate.

Requirements:

- Be 18 years of age or older
- Eligible for employment in Canada
- Possess valid Class 5 Drivers License
- Physically and medically fit
- Clean Driver's Abstract and Criminal Records Check
- Current Standard First Aid and CPR-C
