# Crossfield Community Fest

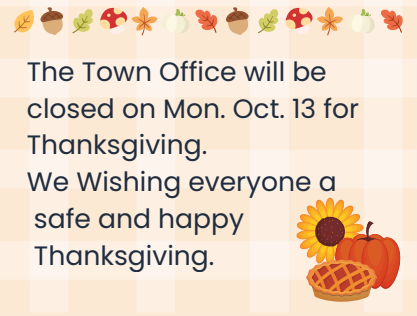

## Working Together to Clear Roads

As we prepare for winter, our crews will begin snow removal operations. Please watch for posted signs, keep vehicles off the roads when required, and if you see our equipment, give them space to work safely. Residents are also asked to remove sporting equipment (such as basketball or hockey nets) from the roadways during the winter season.

Our goal is to clear Priority 1 roads within 36 hours and Priority 2 roads within 60 hours once the snowfall has ended. These timelines are averages and may shift depending on weather conditions, traffic, or unexpected delays. Snow removal is a large operation, and our crews need time to ensure each roadway is cleared thoroughly.

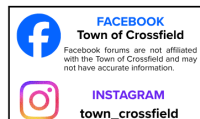
